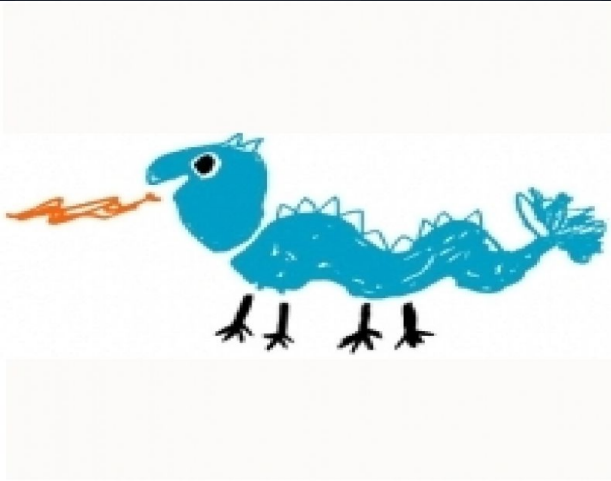

# The Aim

to provide care and support for those  
whom are rescued from human trafficking.  
It aims to rebuild the lives and secure a  
better future for victims.



# Strategies to tackle the problem

- They have provided emergency shelters and care for women and girls who have just escaped sex trafficking
- Medical checks and ongoing care and nutrition to get survivors back to good health
- Medium to long term accommodation for trafficking survivors who cannot return to their communities.
- Assistance to return home and reunite with families
- Psychological counselling to recover from trauma, both short term and long term.
- Ongoing assistance to return to school, university or training.

- Thousands of Vietnamese women and children are trafficked day and night out of Vietnam.
- Cooperation with Vietnamese Police is still limited
- Sex tourism in Vietnam is growing so as in the SEA region, because of active promotion from American and European sex tourist.

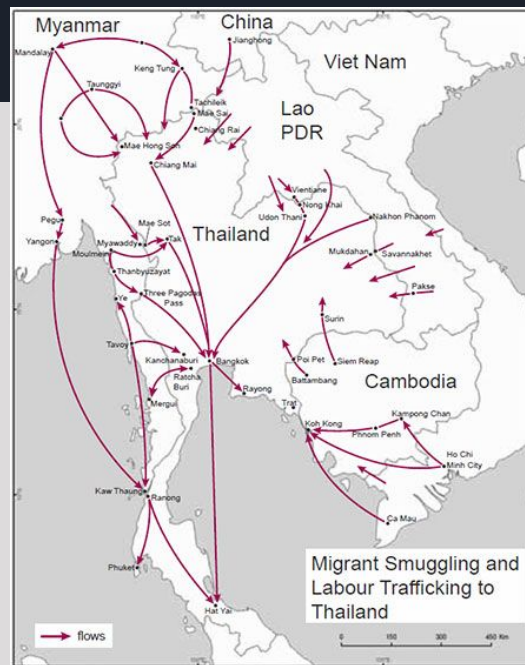
# What are the Limitations?
