Many articles in academic journals are now being published as "open access" articles. This means that everyone can read the article, even if you don't have a subscription. Research that is funded by government bodies and institutions like the EU is required to be published as open access.

Maximise your Google search!

Simple ways to improve your Google search

- Use quotation marks to search for an exact phrase: "British School Jakarta"
- Put a dash before a word to exclude it from your search: apple -fruit
- Use site: to search within a specific website: site:nytimes.com
- Use 2 full stops to search between specific dates: earthquakes 1980..2000
